# CLUB TRANSFERS, CLEARANCES & LOANS FAQS

## Q: Am I allowed to change clubs?

A: Yes. All players are allowed to move to a club of their choice. However, some players can be penalised for moving. Some players are restricted in their movement, including which club.

Q: How do I change clubs?

A: Before lodging a transfer, the player needs to inform both clubs. To make the transfer official, the player then registers to their new club via PlayHQ. The move must be approved by both clubs and GUB. It becomes automatic after 14 days.

## **Q:** What is the difference between a loan and a clearance?

A: A loan is a temporary change of club for one season. When that season is completed, you will be considered a player for your original club again.

A clearance is a permanent change of clubs.

#### **Q:** What are the penalties for changing clubs?

A: Players who participated in the last two seasons of the Victorian Junior Basketball League (VJBL) may carry points. Each club is only allowed a certain amount of points at one time for each year of birth. Clubs should be informed of VJBL participation before starting a transfer.

**Q:** Is a club allowed to refuse a transfer

A: Any transfer (clearance or loan) can only be refused if the players owes their previous club money or hasn't returned club property (eg: uniform).

## **Q:** Can GUB deny a player from transferring?

A: Yes. GUB can deny player movement for a range of reasons, including if the transfer breached the Player Points Value rules that govern junior and senior competitions. A full explanation can be found in our By-Laws
