## LADDER ADJUSTMENTS

### GRADING

When a team is moved post the grading phase, ladder adjustments are applied to ensure teams within the affected grades aren't unfairly advantaged or disadvantaged by the change.

To create the fairest scenario, for the team moving and the teams in the affected grades, the games played outside of grading become draws.

Both teams receive 2 (two) ladder points, even points scored for/against, and will have a win/loss replaced with a draw on their ladder.

See example below

### EXAMPLE

**Team A vs. Team B - Final score: Team A 30 def. Team B 15**  
Following this game, Team B moved down a grade.

#### Before adjustment

Team A receives a win, 3 (three) ladder points, 30 'points for' and 15 'points against'.

Team B receives a loss, 1 (one) ladder point, 15 'points for' and 30 'points against'.

#### After adjustment

Team A loses receives a draw in place of a win and loses 1 (one) ladder point and 15 'points against'.

Team B receives a draw in place of a loss and gains 1 (one) ladder point and 15 'points for'.

*Ladder adjustments will be applied after teams have settled into their final grade, usually Round 9 or 10.*
